Education, Certification and Experience:

Kathryn Morgan Bauer earned her Master of Science in Oriental Medicine degree from Southwest Acupuncture College in 2007. This four-year program consists of 3,000 hours of education including 1,100 hours of clinical practice. She was certified as a Diplomate in Oriental Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in 2008. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and Chinese Herbology. In the summer of 2008, Kathryn completed a two-year, 250 hour apprenticeship focusing on Japanese acupuncture and movement therapy. She is a licensed acupuncturist in the state of Colorado and a member of both the Acupuncture Association of Colorado and the American Acupuncture Council.

Kathryn is trained and experienced in the recommendation and application of adjunctive therapies such as moxibustion, tui na, acupressure, cupping, auriculotherapy, and dietary and lifestyle recommendations. She is also certified in Facial Rejuvenation Acupuncture, Massage and Acupressure as well as Acutonics/Vibrational Medicine. She received her BA in Anthropology from Stanford University in 1996.
